Grumpy Cat, the feline famous on the internet for her permanently "grumpy" facial expression. Her real name was "Tartar Sauce" and was born on April 4th, 2012. Grumpy or Tartar sauce, went viral in 2012 after photographs of her sour expression appeared online. Her image quickly spread as a meme, becoming an American Internet celebrity cat.

Her moody expression was caused by problems in her mouth and feline dwarfism, which made her have short legs and tail, flat face and bubble eyes.

After her debut in 2012, Grumpy Cat made many media appearances and she was the image for cat food brands. Grumpy Cat travelled the world making television appearances and in 2014 even starred in her own Christmas film. This famous cat was often accompanied by her owner, Tabatha Bundesen from Arizona, who said that her cat "helped millions of people smile".

Tartar Sauce died at her home in the arms of her owner Tabatha due to complications from a urinary tract infection on May 14, 2019, at age 7. Her death was announced on May 17, 2019, on social media and many people around the world felt sad. Tributes were posted worldwide.

Grumpy Cat had 8.3 million total likes on Facebook, 2.6 million followers on Instagram, 1.5 million followers on Twitter and 283,000 subscribers on YouTube. Hardly, the world will have a real cat as famous as "Grumpy cat".

How to Be Happy

Behavioral scientists have spent a lot of time studying what makes us happy and what doesn't. We know happiness can give us health and longevity, but happiness isn't something that just happens to you. Everyone has the power to make small changes in their behavior, their surroundings and their relationships that can help make everyone have a happier life. Happiness often comes from inside. We must learn how to manage negative thoughts and face every day with optimism.

All humans have a tendency to remember more bad experiences than positive ones. But that means we have to work a little harder to train our brain to dominate negative thoughts. Here's how:

First, don't try to stop negative thoughts, because it only makes you think about it more. Second, treat yourself like a friend, giving yourself good advice and try to apply it to you. Third, challenge your negative thoughts; negative thinking happens to all of us, but if we recognize it and challenge that thinking, we are taking a big step toward a happier life.

Fourth, control your breath; studies have found, for example, that breathing practices can help reduce symptoms associated with anxiety, insomnia, post-traumatic stress disorder, depression and attention deficit disorder. Lastly, practice optimism, it doesn't mean ignoring the reality of difficult situations. An optimist would see the challenge in a more hopeful way, like a chance to learn and keep moving on.
