The Thames Tunnel was a tunnel built under the river Thames in London. It was the first tunnel ever built under the river, and many people considered it an amazing achievement when it was first available; some even called it the eighth wonder of the world, although this was an exaggeration.

In 1843, it opened to pedestrians only, attracting people from far and wide to see the wonder. On its first day, five thousand people entered the tunnel and walked its length of almost 400 meters. The Thames Tunnel served people from all classes. The working class used it to cross from one side of the river to another, while for the middle and upper classes, it was a tourist experience. In the age of sailing and horse-drawn coaches, people traveled a long way to visit the tunnel, but this was not enough to make the tunnel a financial success. It had cost over £500,000 to complete, which, in those days, was a considerable amount of money. And even though it attracted about 2 million people each year, each person only paid a penny to use it.

The original goal was for the tunnel to be used by trucks to transport cargo so that it could bring in a profit. However, this plan failed, and the tunnel eventually became nothing more than a tourist attraction selling souvenirs. In 1865, the tunnel became part of the London Underground railway system, which continues to be its use today.
