In fact, that was the only time she can remember experiencing fear.

Once, when Mary's sons were small and she was out for a walk, a man called her over. He grabbed her by the shirt, and he held a knife to her neck and told her he was going to cut her. She said, "Go ahead and do it". The man let her go, and she went home, but she didn't call the police, as she didn't see the danger.

She is also unable to recognize a fearful expression on the face of another person. Still, she has normal intelligence and recognizes other emotions such as joy, or anger in the same way as others. If she sees a poisonous snake that would make most people really scared, Mary will touch it without any problem. She isn't afraid in such situations and has no bad memories afterwards. 'If you have no fear, many more terrible things will happen to you,' one of her doctors explained to journalists. 'However, if you have a lot of fear, fewer bad things will probably happen.' So, is it better to be fearful or fearless?
